PARANORMAL 101:

The Poltergeist Phenomenon

Most people have seen the movie *Pol-tergeist*, where a young girl is taken from her family by the malevolent spirits of souls trapped in the hallowed grounds hidden beneath their suburban dream home.

Although I love the movie, it's sequels, and the recent remake, they are really good horror movies. Granted, much of the phenomenon that occurs in the movie (items moving on their own, lights turning on and off, cold spots, etc) are reported during poltergeist phenomenon, poltergeist aren't usually caused by spirits.

That's right. Most of the time, poltergeist phenomenon has a human agent. Yes, a person. In fact, most cases of poltergeist activity occur to pubescent teens, majority female, between ages 11-17. The current theory is that the changes our bodies undergo during puberty, which cause emotional outburst, acts as a trigger for a part of our brains to engage in psychokinesis (the ability to move objects with your mind).

Yet, some others insist that it is caused by lower-level demonic entities or malicious spirits. Both cases have merits, and both angles have been investigated thoroughly through the years by many investigators on many cases.

In going with the psychokinesis theory, parapsychologists and paranormal researchers alike have touted multiple cases, including the Enfield Poltergeist case (See next issue), as demonstrating that emotionally unbalanced or sensitive pubescent teenagers can cause psychokinetic outbursts, acting as an 'agent''.



One investigator found that the target of the poltergeist phenomenon he was investigating was always someone with whom the "agent" recently argued or had a disagreement with. Yet others cite cases such as the "Bell Witch" and Borley Rectory as prime examples of Poltergeist Phenomenon.

In the Bell Witch case, a man named John Bell and his family experienced all kinds of paranormal activity, from scratching to hearing heavy breathing and cackling, as well as object levitating and persons being physically attacked. It was rumored that the spirit of an old woman he crossed was seeking revenge. In the end, John Bell was poisoned to death, allegedly by the Bell Witch herself.

Some other angles and research on this case have yielded the possibility that one of John Bell's daughters, emotionally distraught from her drunk and abusive father, was acting as a poltergeist agent, and that she herself was actually the "Bell Witch".

So, it still isn't very clear exactly what a poltergeist is. Most researchers accept the theory involving the human "agent", while others still insist Activity ranged from strange footsteps to its purely paranormal or evil in nature, and it targets

> It's hard to say one way or another, as some cases display signs or "symptoms" of multiple types of paranormal phenomenon. It is also true that many reports of demonic activity do include poltergeist-like activity at various stages of the encounter.

> You can also have poltergeist-like activity at other hauntings, as well, as some spirits may manifest and throw an object or move something to catch your attention. However, this doesn't necessarily mean that it is a poltergeist.

> One of the hardest parts of the field is sorting out all of the events and incidents and trying to determine exactly what type of spirit you are dealing with (see our past issues of the Informant for information on the types of ghosts, spirits and hauntings!)

> In the event you deal with a classic poltergeist, the kind with a human agent, the best way to find a resolution is to determine what is causing the agent to "act out", and try to find resolution for the individual and family at the source of the issue.

HITCH-HIKING RESURRECTION MARY

Nearly everyone has heard of the classic phantom hitch-hiker scenario. A driver sees a hitchhiking woman late at night on the side of the road. They pick her up, and take her to her home. However, when they arrive, the woman is no where to be found, and when they inquire about her, they discover that she has been dead for a long time.

Chicago is no stranger to these scenarios. Multiple witnesses have reported picking up a wide range of spirits along the roadside over the years. One of the most famous is Resurrection Mary.

Many researchers believe that Resurrection Mary is the ghost of Mary Bregovy, who died in a 1934 car accident while driving on the Chicago Loop downtown. Ursula Bielski, who authored Chicago Haunts, traced a connection to a Anna Marija (Maria) Norkus, who died in 1927 in an auto accident on the way home from the Oh Henry Ball-It is rumored that Mary went out with her room, which many now accept as the most potential

> Resurrection Mary has been featured in folklore, multiple research papers, and even has been featured in a few songs, most notably "Resurrection Mary" by Ian Hunter on his 1996 album the Artful Dodger.





The phenomenon remained popular into the 20th century with support from famous folks such as Sir Arthur Conan Doyle and William Crookes (the pioneer of the vacuum tube).
